Let's Talk Farm Talk: Pumpkins

As you watch the video, look for different parts of the pumpkin plant.

Do you see different shapes?

Do you see different colors?

Do you see parts that grow later?

Are there parts you can't see?

Stem

The stem is the strong, central part of a plant. The other plant parts grow off of it.

Roots

Roots hold onto the soil, giving it a strong base.



Leaves

Leaves make food for the plant through photosynthesis.

Flowers

When the flowers get pollinated, they form the fruit of the plant.

Fruit

The fruit holds the seeds of the plant. Seeds grow into more of the plant!

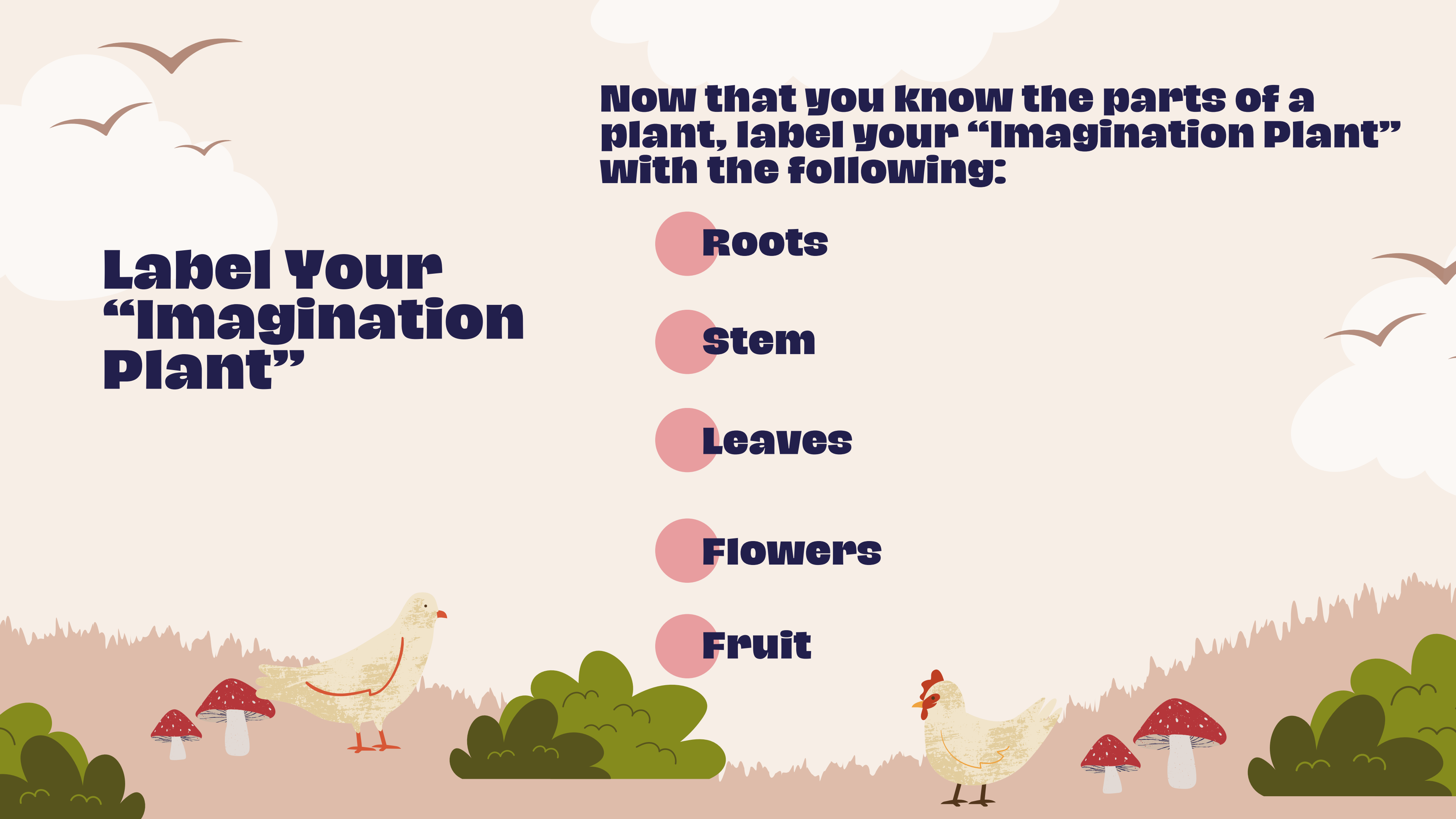
