	animals need food in order to live and grow. They obtain their food from plants

Learning	Students will be able to determine what four things plants need in order to
Target	grow.
Rationale	All organisms need to consume energy in some form. They also must have
	other needs met in order to grow and prosper. Plants that we eat need to be
	healthy in order for us to be healthy.
Tasks	Guided Inquiry: Create a "Need/Have/Are" chart. Discuss with the class what
	plants need. What they have. And what they are. Today, we'll be focusing on
	what they need.
	Mini Lesson: Plants need four things to grow:
	1) Soil: The dirt that a plant grows in. This is where they draw nutrients
	from.
	2) Air: Plants use air in making their food, and they also "breathe."
	3) Water: Plants use water to cool themselves, and in making their own
	food.
	4) Sunlight: Plants use sunlight to make their own food.
	Formative Assessment: Students complete the "What do plants need to
	grow?" worksheet.
	1) Using the cutouts, have students find the four things plants need to
	grow. Separate these from the other items, and hold onto them. They
	will use them in the final assessment.
	2) Glue the four items onto the "What do plants need to grow?" worksheet
	3) Optional: With the other items, discuss what things DO need those
	items to grow/move/work.
